#### Travel

Lisbon is a small city, and metro can be a good option to travel around.

From the airport (LIS) you can take the following public transports:

- [metro](#) (red line) that will take you straight to S. Sebastião station (from 6:30 am till 1:00 am)
- [buses](#) that provide regular links between the airport and important points in the city (from 7:30 am till 11:00 pm)

Taxis and Uber services are also available.
